

### Kaitlin's Crocheted Nail Polish Bottle



At 3" tall, this crocheted nail polish bottle is the same size as the real thing—but NO spills! This pattern makes up VERY fast and is a wonderful little thank you gift for your favorite nail tech or cosmetologist. Perfect for that girly-girl that can't get their hands on enough nail polish! It's also great for random acts of kindness, on a Christmas tree, keychain, or sitting on one's own bureau.

This design requires a basic understanding of crochet techniques such as increasing/decreasing, adding on yarn, and ability to make basic crochet stitches. ## Supplies

G hook

[Soft Payette Yarn](#) (Shown in Karat and Rose Quartz)

Quaker Black Acrylic 1500 Chenille Yarn

Fiberfill

## Abbreviations:

ch=chain

sc=single crochet

hdc=half double crochet

dc=double crochet

tc=triple crochet

sls=slip stitch

sk=skip

## Directions:

**Note: In order to get the placement of the sequins on the outside of the finished object; the crocheting is done from the inside throughout.**

Row 1: With doubled Soft Payette Yarn: ch 2, 5 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> st from hook (5)



Row 2: (sc 2 in st) 5x (10)



Row 3: (sc 1, sc 2 in st) 5x (15)

Row 4: sc 15 in front loop only (15)



Rows 5-10: sc 15 (15)



Row 11: (sc 2 tog) 7x, sc 1, STUFF

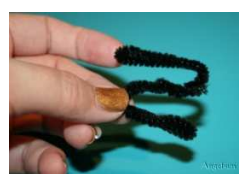
Row 12: Join on doubled black yarn for the lid, sc 8 (8)



Rows 13-17: sc 8 (8)



Row 18: Insert chenille stem folded in half, twist, then fold into thirds, twist.



(sc 2 tog) 4x, tie off and bury end in the work.



Finishing: Weave in starting and joining ends.
