Supplies:

Scraps of worsted weight yarn

G—Crochet Hook

6mm Swarovski Crystals

4mm pearls



Abbreviations:

ch=chain

sc=single crochet

hdc=half double crochet

dc=double crochet

tc=triple crochet

sls=slip stitch

sk=skip

Directions:

Ch 56, sls to form ring

Row 1: sc in each st (56)

Row 2: 16 sc, hdc 2, dc 20, hdc 2, sc 16 (56)

Row 3: sls 16,(sc, hdc, dc, sk st, ch 1) 11x, hdc, sc, ch 1, turn.

Row 4: sls 2x, sc in st—ch 2, sc in 2nd st sls in next st (above open area) 3x (3 small points formed)

*Hdc, sc in 2nd st, hdc, sls in 2nd st, sls over (above post dc) hdc in same stitch and repeat * 3x (large points)

Make 3 more small points as above, sls and tie off. Weave in ends.



Hand sew pearls and crystals as shown.
