Supplies

US 9 Needles 5.5 mm

Scraps of Moda Dea Waterlily or other Fuzzy Yarn

Plastic Tapestry Needle

4 mm Black Beads

Needle/Thread

Fiberfill

Directions

Body:

Row 1: CO 4 st, (K 2 in st) 4x (8)





Row 2: P8

Row 3: (K 2 in st)8x (16)



Row 4: P 16

Rows 5-8: SS (K,P, K, P) (16)

Row 9: (K 2 tog)8x (8)



Row 10: P 8 (8)

Row 11: (K 2 tog) 4x (4) Slide off on to Tapestry Needle, Draw in and tie off. (This is the butt end.)





Stuff lightly with Fiberfill. Mattress Stitch Shut.



Ear (Make 2):

Row 1: CO 3 K

Row 2: P

Row 3: K

Row 4: P

Row 5: K

Row 6: P

Row7: k 2 tog, k 1, sl over, tie off



Weave in the end of yarn on the tip of the ear.



Sew base of ear to top of bunny head. Pinch ear in half and sew to hold.

Tail:Wind yarn several times around 2 fingers.



Tie in the middle and pull up tightly.



Cut both loop ends with scissors.



Trim to make a ½" pom pom.



Sew pom pom to butt.



Eyes:

Sew eyes to the front of the head. Pull up the thread semi-tight to indent the knitting and make an eye socket. Tie off.



Whiskers:



Pull thread through nose area as shown. Tie ends on one side (double knot). Tie ends on the other side (double knot). Trim to desired length.

Dust Bunnies are NOT suitable for small children.

To avoid the wrath of dust bunnies everywhere, keep away from dust pans. BEWARE! Dust Bunnies multiply!
